Our Facility



Curran Renewable Energy is a completely new 100,000 ton annual production wood pellet production facility located on 8 acres in Massena, NY. Our facility produces consistent high quality wood pellets from whole tree chips that are harvested from our sister company Seaway Timber Harvesting. Clean whole tree chips are pulverized, dried to a consistent moisture level and re-pulverized finer using state of the art technology before being pressed into a wood pellet. Once the chips are processed in to a wood pellet they are then cooled, screened and stored in our 750 ton silo ready to be bagged on our fully automated/robotic bagging line. Bagged, weather tight palletized product is then stored inside in our 30,000 sq/ft heated warehouse waiting to be loaded on a truck for delivery to your location.

Shipping out of our warehouse can be arranged on open flat bed or van style enclosed trailers depending on the customers needs. Curran Renewable Energy also offers delivery of their pellets using their own trucks and flatbeds within NY and Canada and is permitted to haul 40 ton loads saving the customer money on freight. Freight outside of these locations can be picked up or scheduled with a broker to meet your specific needs.

Our Product



Curran Renewable Energy purchases 100% of the necessary starting stock from their sister company Seaway Timber Harvesting. Seaway Timber Harvesting has been in the forestry management business for decades. Because of this relationship we control the supply of wood -- right down to the number of trees harvested, the species of trees, balance of hardwood and softwood and what parts of those trees end up in our products. This results in a higher quality wood pellet being produced to meet the demands of our customers... to keep you warm all winter long.

The relationship between Seaway Timber Harvesting and Curran Renewable Energy assures total control, consistent and reliable source of the raw materials needed to supply our 100,000 ton capacity wood pellet production facility. You will find our pellet supply is as reliable as it gets and the quality of our pellets is exceptional.



Our History



Stewardship of the land is what drives Seaway Timber Harvesting to be an innovative leader in harvesting forest products today. Our roots grow deep with the North Country heritage of hard work, sweat equity and the steadfast determination of Michael & Pauline Curran, Sr. and their sons. In 1976, they began a family logging business - armed only with chainsaws, a used logging truck and a doodle-bug built to be their first skidder. Then in 1984, Curran Logging was established and in 1990, Seaway Timber Harvesting was incorporated - owned and operated by Pat, Tim and Lee Curran, and over 100 dedicated full and part time employees from 4 counties working in the forest product and management industry.

Today, forest harvesting has become totally mechanized, creating more product with less waste and enabling better care of the land. The #1 issue of forest management in the northern tier was replacing the felling of trees by chain saw and turning it all into mechanized harvesting. With good mechanical operators and advanced mechanized equipment, we are able to have much better control of land management and able to create better overall stewardship of the land.

Hard work, sweat equity and care from our employees has made Seaway Timber Harvesting a leader in the forest harvesting industry today.
